## Gaming - Sports Wagering - Exemption for Sports-Based State Lottery Game

FOR the purpose of excluding from the definition of "sports wagering" the sale or purchase of certain sports-based State lottery game tickets; and generally relating to sports wagering in the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government
9-1E-01.
(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
(j) (1) "Sports wagering" means the business of accepting wagers on any sporting event by any system or method of wagering, including single-game bets, teaser bets, parlays, over-under, moneyline, pools, exchange wagering, in-game wagering,
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

1 in-play bets, proposition bets, and straight bets.
(2) "SPORTS WAGERING" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE SALE OR 3 PURCHASE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBTITLE 1 OF THIS TITLE, OF A STATE LOTTERY 4 GAME TICKET ON WHICH SELECTIONS ARE MADE BY THE PLAYER OR RANDOMLY 5 GENERATED AND FOR WHICH THE WINNING NUMBERS ARE RANDOMLY GENERATED 6 AND BASED ON THE OUTCOME OF ACTUAL SPORTING EVENTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 8 1, 2023.
