- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Veterinary Practitioner Student Loan Forgiveness 4 Program to be administered by the Secretary of Agriculture; establishing eligibility 5 requirements for the Program, including requiring participants to complete a service 6 obligation to practice in the State for at least a certain number of years; requiring 7 the Secretary to make an annual disbursement of a certain sum to a veterinary 8 practitioner who meets the service obligation, up to a maximum number of years; 9 and generally relating to the establishment of the Veterinary Practitioner Student 10 Loan Forgiveness Program.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 21 INDICATED.
- 22 (2) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE VETERINARY PRACTITIONER STUDENT
- 23 LOAN FORGIVENESS PROGRAM.



- 1 (3) "QUALIFIED EDUCATIONAL LOAN" MEANS A GOVERNMENT,
- 2 COMMERCIAL, OR FOUNDATION LOAN FOR ACTUAL COSTS PAID FOR TUITION,
- 3 REASONABLE EDUCATION EXPENSES, AND REASONABLE LIVING EXPENSES
- 4 RELATED TO THE POSTGRADUATE EDUCATION OF A VETERINARIAN.
- 5 (4) "VETERINARIAN" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 2–301 OF THIS
- 6 SUBTITLE.
- 7 (5) "VETERINARY PRACTITIONER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §
- 8 2-301 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 9 (B) (1) THERE IS A VETERINARY PRACTITIONER STUDENT LOAN
- 10 FORGIVENESS PROGRAM.
- 11 (2) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.
- 12 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE QUALIFIED
- 13 EDUCATIONAL LOAN FORGIVENESS FOR VETERINARY PRACTITIONERS IN THE
- 14 **STATE.**
- 15 (D) TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM, AN INDIVIDUAL
- 16 SHALL:
- 17 (1) BE A VETERINARY PRACTITIONER WHO HAS AT LEAST \$40,000 IN
- 18 OUTSTANDING EDUCATIONAL LOANS FROM VETERINARY SCHOOL AT THE TIME OF
- 19 SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION; AND
- 20 (2) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY IN THE FORM AND
- 21 MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY.
- 22 (E) AN APPLICANT SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM SHALL
- 23 SIGN A CONTRACT AGREEING TO COMPLETE A SERVICE OBLIGATION TO PRACTICE
- 24 AS A VETERINARIAN IN THE STATE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS.
- 25 (F) (1) EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE SECRETARY MAY SELECT ELIGIBLE
- 26 APPLICANTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM WITHIN THE LIMITS OF
- 27 AVAILABLE FUNDING.
- 28 (2) THE SECRETARY SHALL SELECT PARTICIPANTS BASED ON:
- 29 (I) EXPERIENCE;

- 1 (2) If a veterinary practitioner participating in the 2 Program fails to complete a full year of the service obligation, the 3 Secretary may propate the loan forgiveness payment for that service 4 Year.
- 5 (I) (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, 6 THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION 7 OF \$2,000,000 TO THE PROGRAM.
- 8 (2) THE APPROPRIATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 9 SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR:
- 10 (I) PROVIDING LOAN FORGIVENESS UNDER THE PROGRAM; 11 AND
- 12 (II) ADMINISTERING THE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
