## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 State Information Technology - Social Media Applications - TikTok Prohibition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a certain social media application from being installed or maintained on any information technology owned by a unit of State government; requiring the Department of Budget and Management, in collaboration with the Department of Information Technology, to prepare guidance for units of State government to remove from and prohibit the use of a certain social media application on information technology owned by the unit; and generally relating to social media applications and State information technology.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

10 11 12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31, 2023, the Department of Budget and Management, in collaboration with the Department of Information Technology, shall publish guidelines to assist units of State government in:
13 14	(1) removing the social media application TikTok from information technology owned by the unit;
15 16 17	(2) maintaining an ongoing prohibition on the social media application TikTok being installed or maintained on any information technology owned by the unit; and
18 19	(3) permitting the installation and maintenance of the social media application TikTok where it is necessary for:
20	(i) law enforcement activities;
21	(ii) protecting national security; and
22	(iii) research on security practices.
23 24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
