## State Information Technology – Social Media Applications – TikTok Prohibition Prohibited Applications and Websites

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a certain social media application from being installed or 4 5 maintained certain applications from being used and certain websites from being 6 accessed by certain employees, agents, or entities on any information technology owned or leased by a unit of State government; requiring the Department of Budget 7 8 and Management, in collaboration with the Department of Information Technology, 9 to prepare guidance for units of State government to remove from and prohibit the use of a certain social media application and access to certain applications and 10 websites on information technology owned or leased by the unit; and generally 11 12 relating to social media applications, websites, and State information technology.

8 9 10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31, 2023, the Department of Budget and Management, in collaboration with the Department of Information Technology, shall publish guidelines to assist units of State government in:
11 12 13 14	(1) removing the social media application TikTok and preventing access to applications and websites prohibited under § 3.5–801 of the State Finance and Procurement Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, from information technology owned and leased by the unit;
15 16 17	(2) maintaining an ongoing prohibition on the social media application TikTok prohibited applications and websites being installed or, maintained, or accessed on any information technology owned and leased by the unit; and
18 19	(3) permitting the installation and, maintenance, and access of the social media application TikTok prohibited applications and websites where it is necessary for:
20	(i) law enforcement activities;
21	(ii) protecting national security; and
22	(iii) research on security practices.
23 24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
