Courts - Recordings of Proceedings - Access

- FOR the purpose of requiring an authorized custodian of a recording of a court proceeding to make available on request a copy of the recording; requiring the authorized custodian to ensure that certain portions of a provided recording are redacted; requiring the authorized custodian to make available unredacted recordings of shielded or closed court proceedings to certain individuals; and generally relating to access to recordings of court proceedings.
