- 21 inequalities and injustice that permeate society in the form of unequal pay and treatment

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 24 That Section(s) 7–402 through 7–418 of Article General Provisions of the Annotated Code
- of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–403 through 7–419, respectively.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 3 Article General Provisions
- 4 **7–402.**
- 5 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM MARCH 15 AS EQUAL 6 PAY COMMEMORATION DAY.
- 7 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE GOVERNMENTAL, EDUCATIONAL, 8 AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS TO REFLECT ON THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF WOMEN
- 9 TO THE ECONOMY AND ON EFFORTS TO ESTABLISH AND PROMOTE EQUALITY IN THE
- 10 WORKPLACE THROUGH APPROPRIATE AND INFORMATIVE PROGRAMS AND
- 11 ACTIVITIES.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 2023.
