22 (b) If the dentist receives a passing score on the ADEX examination, the dentist 23 may apply for a general license to practice dentistry.

(c) A dentist who applied for a general license to practice dentistry under
subsection (b) of this section and was issued a general license shall surrender the license if
the dentist violates any provision of this title or any regulation adopted by the Board.
