A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **County Boards of Education – Blueprint for Maryland’s Future Implementation**
3 **Coordinator – Salary Grant**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State, for certain fiscal years, to provide a grant to each
5 county board of education for the salary of a Blueprint for Maryland’s Future
6 implementation coordinator in each county; and generally relating to a salary grant
7 to county boards for Blueprint for Maryland’s Future implementation coordinators.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 (b) (2) State and local government units responsible for implementing an
23 element of the Blueprint for Maryland’s Future shall develop implementation plans
24 consistent with the Comprehensive Implementation Plan that describe the goals,
25 objectives, and strategies that will be used to improve student achievement and meet the

1 Blueprint for Maryland's Future recommendations for each segment of the student
2 population.

3 (h) (1) For each of fiscal years 2022 through 2026, the governing body of a
4 county and the local school system jointly shall appoint a single implementation
5 coordinator responsible for the implementation of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future by
6 all government units operating in the county.

7 (2) FOR EACH OF FISCAL YEARS 2025 AND 2026, THE STATE SHALL
8 PROVIDE A GRANT OF \$150,000 TO EACH COUNTY BOARD FOR THE SALARY OF THE
9 IMPLEMENTATION COORDINATOR APPOINTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH
10 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
12 1, 2023.
