- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 5 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COMPENSATION" INCLUDES STIPENDS FOR 6 TRANSPORTATION, TRAINING, AND BONUS PAYMENTS.
- 7 [(a)] (B) (1) A local board may fix the compensation of election judges within 8 the limits authorized for this purpose by the county's governing body.
- 9 <u>(I) THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY SHALL PROVIDE</u> 10 <u>SUFFICIENT FUNDING TO MEET THE MINIMUM COMPENSATION LEVELS REQUIRED</u> 11 UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 12 <u>(II) WITHIN THE LIMITS AUTHORIZED BY THE COUNTY</u>
- 13 GOVERNING BODY, A LOCAL BOARD MAY FIX THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTION
