- 1 (3) "ENTERTAINMENT VENUE" MEANS A FACILITY THAT IS USED AS A CINEMA, A THEATER, AN AMPHITHEATER, A CONCERT HALL, OR A SPORTS STADIUM.
- 3 (B) (1) EACH ENTERTAINMENT VENUE SHALL:
- 4 (I) OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE TO OPERATE AND MAKE AVAILABLE
- 5 AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 13–517 OF THE
- 6 EDUCATION ARTICLE; AND
- 7 (II) HAVE AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR
- 8 AVAILABLE FOR USE ON THE PREMISES OF THE ENTERTAINMENT VENUE.
- 9 (2) EACH ENTERTAINMENT VENUE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE
- 10 CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 13-517 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE AND
- 11 ESTABLISHED BY THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BOARD.
- 12 (C) WHEN OPEN FOR BUSINESS, EACH ENTERTAINMENT VENUE SHALL
- 13 HAVE ON THE PREMISES AN EMPLOYEE WHO, THROUGH TRAINING WITH THE
- 14 AMERICAN RED CROSS OR A PROGRAM WITH EQUIVALENT STANDARDS, IS
- 15 CERTIFIED IN FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION.

- 17 CIVILLY LIABLE FOR AN ACT OR OMISSION REGARDING THE PRESENCE OR USE OF
- 18 OR FAILURE TO USE AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR.
