1 AN ACT concerning

Office of the Attorney General – Violent Crimes Special Prosecution Unit for Baltimore City

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Violent Crimes Special Prosecution Unit for Baltimore $\mathbf{5}$ City in the Office of the Attorney General to prosecute violent crimes in Baltimore 6 City; prohibiting certain attorneys appointed to the Unit from otherwise practicing 7 law during the period of the appointment; requiring certain law enforcement 8 agencies to assign certain police officers to the Unit; requiring the Chief Special 9 Prosecutor to engage with certain federal law enforcement agencies for a certain purpose; requiring the Governor to make certain efforts to enter into an agreement 10 11 with the United States Attorney for the District of Maryland for a certain purpose; 12and generally relating to the Violent Crimes Special Prosecution Unit for Baltimore 13 City.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 (7) ATTEMPT, CONSPIRACY, OR SOLICITATION TO COMMIT A CRIME 13 LISTED IN ITEMS (1) THROUGH (6) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

15 (A) THERE IS A VIOLENT CRIMES SPECIAL PROSECUTION UNIT FOR 16 BALTIMORE CITY IN THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

17 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE UNIT IS TO PROSECUTE VIOLENT CRIMES IN 18 BALTIMORE CITY, IN COORDINATION WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAW 19 ENFORCEMENT.

20 **6–703.**

21 (A) THE UNIT SHALL INCLUDE:

22 (1) A CHIEF SPECIAL PROSECUTOR APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

23 (2) A DEPUTY SPECIAL PROSECUTOR;

24 (3) EIGHT SENIOR SPECIAL PROSECUTORS RESPONSIBLE FOR 25 WIRETAPS AND MULTIDEFENDANT CRIMINAL ORGANIZATION PROSECUTIONS;

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EIGHT SENIOR SPECIAL PROSECUTORS RESPONSIBLE FOR 1 (4) $\mathbf{2}$ **PROSECUTING HOMICIDES AND SHOOTINGS;** 3 (5) EIGHT SPECIAL PROSECUTORS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROSECUTING CARJACKING, BURGLARY, AND FIREARMS CASES AND ASSISTING SENIOR SPECIAL 4 **PROSECUTORS, AS NECESSARY; AND** 56 SUPPORT STAFF INCLUDING LAW CLERKS AND ADMINISTRATIVE (6) 7 ASSISTANTS. 8 THE CHIEF SPECIAL PROSECUTOR SHALL HAVE AN ANNUAL **(B)** (1) 9 SALARY OF \$150,000. 10 (2) THE DEPUTY SPECIAL PROSECUTOR SHALL HAVE AN ANNUAL 11 SALARY OF \$125,000. EACH SENIOR SPECIAL PROSECUTOR SHALL HAVE AN ANNUAL 12(3) SALARY OF \$125,000. 13 14(4) EACH SPECIAL PROSECUTOR SHALL HAVE AN ANNUAL SALARY OF 15\$115,000. 16 EACH SUPPORT STAFF MEMBER SHALL HAVE AN ANNUAL SALARY (5) 17OF \$85,000. 18 6-704. (1) A STATE'S ATTORNEY FOR A COUNTY MAY NOMINATE UP TO FOUR 19 (A) ASSISTANT STATE'S ATTORNEYS FOR APPOINTMENT AS A PROSECUTOR FOR THE 20UNIT BY THE CHIEF SPECIAL PROSECUTOR. 2122(2) THE CHIEF SPECIAL PROSECUTOR MAY APPOINT ONE OR MORE 23PRIVATE ATTORNEYS TO SERVE AS PROSECUTORS IN THE UNIT. 24AN ASSISTANT STATE'S ATTORNEY OR PRIVATE ATTORNEY (3) 25APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT OTHERWISE PRACTICE LAW DURING 26THE PERIOD OF THE APPOINTMENT. 27APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, INCLUDING THE **(B)** 28BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT, SHALL ASSIGN DEDICATED POLICE OFFICERS

2 (A) THE CHIEF SPECIAL PROSECUTOR SHALL ENGAGE WITH THE FEDERAL 3 BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, THE UNITED STATES DRUG ENFORCEMENT 4 ADMINISTRATION, AND THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, 5 FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES WITH THE GOAL OF ARRANGING FOR THE ASSIGNMENT 6 OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS TO ASSIST IN THE WORK OF THE UNIT.

7 (B) (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL MAKE EFFORTS TO ENTER INTO AN 8 AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FOR THE DISTRICT OF 9 MARYLAND FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ONE OR MORE ATTORNEYS FROM THE UNIT 10 AS SPECIAL UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURSUING FEDERAL 11 CHARGES RELATED TO THE DUTIES OF THE UNIT.

12 (2) THE UNIT MAY ALLOCATE FUNDS PROVIDED TO THE UNIT IN THE 13 ANNUAL BUDGET TO THE SALARY OF AN ATTORNEY APPOINTED AS SPECIAL UNITED 14 STATES ATTORNEY UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

16 (A) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 17 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF 18 AT LEAST \$10,000,000 FOR THE UNIT.

19 **(B) OF THE APPROPRIATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS** 20 **SECTION, THE UNIT SHALL ALLOCATE:**

21 (1) \$1,000,000 FOR INCENTIVES TO EXPAND THE GROUND CAMERA 22 NETWORK IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND

23(2) \$2,000,000FORWIRETAPS,UNDERCOVERDRUG24INVESTIGATIONS, AND FORENSIC ANALYSTS.

26 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY 27 OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 29 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2026, 30 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and 31 of no further force and effect.

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
