# 2 Criminal Law – Public Utility Interference – Damage or Impairment by Firearm 3 or Destructive Device

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from willfully using a firearm or destructive device
  to destroy or damage, or obstruct, impede, or impair the service or transmission of,
  a gasoline, natural gas, propane, or electric utility system owned or operated by a
  gas company or an electric company; prohibiting a person from willfully aiding,
  conspiring with, or employing another to violate this Act; and generally relating to
  public utility interference.

#### HOUSE BILL 1296

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 2 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has 3 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to 4 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is 5 enacted.
