6 **(**A**)** EACH STATE COURT IN THE SHALL **PROVIDE** REMOTE 7 AUDIO-VISUAL PUBLIC ACCESS FOR ALL PUBLIC COURT PROCEEDINGS, UNLESS A PROCEEDING IS DEEMED CLOSED, CONFIDENTIAL, OR RESTRICTED BY FEDERAL OR 8 9 STATE LAW.

10 **(B)** UNLESS THERE IS AN OVERRIDING PUBLIC INTEREST COMPELLING 11 DISCLOSURE, A PRESIDING JUDGE MAY PROHIBIT THE BROADCAST OF ANY PORTION 12 OF A PROCEEDING ON THE REQUEST OF ANY PARTY, WITNESS, OR COUNSEL 13 INVOLVED IN THE PROCEEDING.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2023.
