## Public Institutions of Higher Education – Transcript Requests by Students With Unpaid Student Account Balances

- FOR the purpose of requiring a public institution of higher education to allow certain students with an unpaid balance on a student account that is a certain amount or less to request and receive a transcript; requiring a public institution of higher education to allow certain students with an unpaid balance on a student account that is greater than a certain amount to request and receive a transcript under certain circumstances; and generally relating to public institutions of higher education and transcript requests from students with unpaid balances on student accounts.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 **15–136.**
- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "STUDENT" INCLUDES CURRENT STUDENTS AND 21 FORMER STUDENTS OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

- 1 (B) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOW A 2 STUDENT WITH AN UNPAID BALANCE OF \$1,000 OR LESS ON A STUDENT ACCOUNT 3 TO REQUEST AND RECEIVE A TRANSCRIPT.
- 4 (C) (1) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOW A STUDENT WITH AN UNPAID BALANCE OF MORE THAN \$1,000 ON A STUDENT ACCOUNT TO REQUEST AND RECEIVE A TRANSCRIPT IF THE STUDENT ENTERS INTO AN INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PLAN WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE DAY ON WHICH THE STUDENT MAKES THE REQUEST.
- 9 (2) THE INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PLAN UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF 10 THIS SUBSECTION SHALL REQUIRE THE STUDENT TO MAKE PAYMENTS TO SETTLE 11 THE UNPAID BALANCE ON THE STUDENT ACCOUNT BY THE AGREED—ON DATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2023.
