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Correctional Officers' Retirement System – Talbot County

- FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System
 for certain local detention center officers of Talbot County in the event Talbot County
 becomes a participating governmental unit in the Correctional Officers' Retirement
 System; providing that certain local detention center officers who join the
 Correctional Officers' Retirement System and receive certain service credit shall no
 longer be members of the Employees' Pension System; and generally relating to
 Talbot County's participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 18 **31–2B–08.**

19 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A LOCAL DETENTION

4 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IF TALBOT 5 COUNTY BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE CORRECTIONAL 6 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, MEMBERSHIP IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' 7 RETIREMENT SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER 8 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

9 (C) IF TALBOT COUNTY COMMENCES PARTICIPATION IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH 10 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION 11 (A) OF THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE 1213SERVICE IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR 14EMPLOYMENT WITH TALBOT COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 (D) ON JOINING THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM 16 AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 17 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 18 SHALL:

19 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION 20 SYSTEM; AND

21 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES' 22 PENSION SYSTEM.

23 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL 24 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE 25 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO 26 TRANSFERS TO THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER THIS 27 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE **37** OF THIS ARTICLE.

28 (F) IF TALBOT COUNTY BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT 29 IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, § 31–2B–05(C) OF THIS 30 SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER AND CREDITING OF ASSETS ON THE 31 EFFECTIVE DATE.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 33 1, 2023.
