# 17 A PERSON MAY CATCH OR ATTEMPT TO CATCH CRABS FOR RECREATIONAL 18 PURPOSES IN THE WATERS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TIDAL TRIBUTARIES 19 WITHOUT A RECREATIONAL CRABBING LICENSE IF THE PERSON IS UNDER THE AGE 20 OF 16 YEARS.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 22 1, 2023.
