- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BEHAVIORAL HEALTH WELLNESS VISIT" MEANS A
- 19 COMPREHENSIVE VISIT TO ASSESS THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF
- 20 AN INDIVIDUAL THAT INCLUDES SCREENING AND, AS APPROPRIATE, BRIEF
- 21 INTERVENTION AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ADDITIONAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
- 22 CARE SERVICES FOR THE PREVENTION OF AND EARLY INTERVENTION FOR
- 23 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CONDITIONS.

- 5 CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND
- 6 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE
- 7 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER
- 8 CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.
- 9 (C) (1) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE
- 10 COVERAGE FOR AN ANNUAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH WELLNESS VISIT.
- 11 (2) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE

- 13 SAME BASIS AND AT THE SAME RATE AS AN ANNUAL WELLNESS VISIT FOR SOMATIC

- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all
- policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or
- 17 after January 1, 2024.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 January 1, 2024.
