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

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that the Maryland Food System Resiliency Council is in
- 4 the Office of Resilience in the Maryland Department of Emergency Management;
- 5 altering the process for electing a cochair of the Council; and generally relating to
- 6 the Maryland Food System Resiliency Council.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article – Public Safety

- 16 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 17 (b) "Council" means the Maryland Food System Resiliency Council.
- 18 (c) ["Director" means the Director of the Maryland Emergency Management
- 19 Agency.
- 20 (d)] "Food council organization" means a local food council organization that is
- 21 established in the State.





one representative of a statewide food security advocacy 1 (vi) 2 organization: 3 (vii) one farmer in the State: one owner of a food business in the State: 4 (viii) 5 (ix) one expert in food system policy; 6 (x) one expert on racial equity in the food system; 7 (xi) one expert on food system impacts on climate and the 8 environment: 9 (xii) one expert on food nutrition and public health; and (xiii) any other individual that the [Director] SECRETARY deems 10 11 appropriate. 12 (c) The [Director] **SECRETARY** shall: 13 ensure that all five geographic areas of the State are represented by the appointed members of the Council; and 14 15 (2) appoint a successor in the event of a vacancy on the Council. 16 The term of a member of the Council appointed by the [Director] (d) (1) (i) 17 **SECRETARY** is 3 years. 18 An appointed member may not serve for more than 2 consecutive (ii) 19 three year terms. 20 At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is (2)appointed and qualifies. 2122 A member who is appointed after a term has begun shall serve for the 23 rest of the term or until a successor is appointed and qualifies. 24A member of the Council: (e) may not receive compensation as a member of the Council; but 25 (1) 26 is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 27 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State Budget.

A majority of the members then serving on the Council is a quorum.

- 1 (g) (1) (i) The [Director] **SECRETARY**, or the [Director's] **SECRETARY'S**2 designee, and one member [representing a food council organization] who is elected in
 3 accordance with subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph shall cochair the Council.
- 4 (ii) At the first meeting of each year, the Council shall elect a cochair from among the [five] Council members [representing food council organizations] for a term of 1 year.
- 7 (2) The Secretary of Agriculture, or the Secretary's designee, the Secretary 8 of Human Services, or the Secretary's designee, and the Dean of the University of Maryland 9 College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, or the Dean's designee shall co—vice chair 10 the Council.
- 11 (h) (1) The Council may establish subcommittees to provide technical 12 assistance to the Council.
- 13 (2) The Council may establish subcommittee topics and membership as the Council deems appropriate.
- 15 (i) The [Maryland Emergency Management Agency and the University of Maryland College of Agriculture and Natural Resources] **DEPARTMENT** shall provide staff for the Council[, as deemed necessary by the cochairs].
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
