 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through July 1, 2025, and, at the end of July 1, 2025, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
