CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Municipalities – Charter Amendments – Notice**

3 FOR the purpose of modifying the manner in which the chief executive officer of a
4 municipality may fulfill certain notice requirements; requiring the municipality to
5 maintain certain records or receipts and make the records or receipts available to
6 the public; and generally relating to methods of providing notice of municipal charter
7 amendment resolutions.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Local Government**

16 4–304.

17 (b) **(1)** The chief executive officer of the municipality shall give notice of the
18 resolution that proposes an amendment to the municipal charter by:

1 **[(1)] (I)** posting an exact copy of the resolution at the main municipal
2 building or other public place for the 40 days after the resolution is adopted; and

3 **[(2)] (II) 1.** publishing a fair summary of the proposed amendment in
4 a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality:

5 **[(i)] A.** at least four times;

6 **[(ii)] B.** at weekly intervals; and

7 **[(iii)] C.** within the 40 days after the resolution is adopted; **OR**

8 **2. A. PUBLISHING A FAIR SUMMARY OF THE**
9 **PROPOSED AMENDMENT IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE**
10 **MUNICIPALITY AT LEAST ONCE; AND**

11 **B. DELIVERING A COPY OF A FAIR SUMMARY OF THE**
12 **PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT EITHER BY HAND OR BY MAIL ONCE TO EVERY**
13 **RESIDENCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY.**

14 **(2) THE DELIVERY REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(II)2B OF THIS**
15 **SUBSECTION MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED BY INCLUDING A FAIR SUMMARY OF THE**
16 **PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT IN A PRINTED NEWSLETTER OR ANY OTHER**
17 **REGULAR MUNICIPAL PUBLICATION.**

18 **(3) THE MUNICIPALITY DELIVERING A COPY OF A FAIR SUMMARY**
19 **UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(II)2B OF THIS SECTION SHALL:**

20 **(I) MAINTAIN A RECORD OF OR A COPY OF THE RECEIPT FOR**
21 **THE DELIVERY UNDER THE RECORDS RETENTION AND DOCUMENT DISPOSAL**
22 **SCHEDULE OF THE MUNICIPALITY; AND**

23 **(II) MAKE THE RECORD OR COPY AVAILABLE TO THE GENERAL**
24 **PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MARYLAND PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT.**

26 **(f) (1)** The chief executive officer of the municipality shall give notice of a
27 submission of a proposed charter amendment by:

28 **[(1)] (i) 1.** posting an exact copy of the proposed amendment at the
29 main municipal building or other public place for at least ~~4 weeks~~ **40 DAYS** immediately
30 preceding the referendum at which the question is to be submitted; and
