A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Occupations – Licenses, Certificates, and Registrations – Immigrants**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a health occupations board from denying a license,
4 certification, or registration to an immigrant if the individual meets certain
5 requirements; requiring each health occupations board to require each applicant for
6 a license to disclose the Social Security number or Individual Taxpayer Identification
7 Number of the applicant and record the number on the application; and generally
8 relating to applications for health occupations licenses, certifications, or
9 registrations by immigrants.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article – Family Law**

3 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

4 (2) “License” means any license, certificate, registration, permit, or other
5 authorization that:

6 (i) is issued by a licensing authority;

7 (ii) is subject to suspension, revocation, forfeiture, or termination by
8 a licensing authority; and

9 (iii) is necessary for an individual to practice or engage in:

10 1. a particular business, occupation, or profession; or

11 2. recreational hunting or fishing.

12 (3) (i) “Licensing authority” means a department, unit of a department,
13 commission, board, office, or court of the State.

14 (ii) “Licensing authority” includes:

15 1. the Maryland Department of Labor;

16 2. the Maryland Department of Health;

17 3. the Department of Human Services;

18 4. the Department of Transportation;

19 5. the Department of the Environment;

20 6. the Comptroller of the Treasury;

21 7. the Department of Agriculture;

22 8. the Maryland Insurance Administration;

23 9. the Public Service Commission;

24 10. the Secretary of State;

25 11. the State Department of Education;

1 12. the Department of Natural Resources;

2 13. the Office of the Attorney General;

3 14. the clerks of the court that are authorized to issue a license
4 or certificate for professional services or recreational uses; and

5 15. the Court of Appeals.

6 (b) (1) Except as provided in [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) of this
7 subsection, a licensing authority shall:

8 (i) require each applicant for a license to disclose the Social Security
9 number of the applicant; and

10 (ii) record the applicant's Social Security number on the application.

11 (2) The Department of Natural Resources shall:

12 (i) require an applicant for a recreational hunting or fishing license
13 to disclose only the last four digits of the Social Security number of the applicant instead of
14 the full Social Security number; and

15 (ii) record the applicant's partial Social Security number on the
16 application.

17 **(3) EACH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD SHALL:**

18 **(I) REQUIRE EACH APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO DISCLOSE**
19 **THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION**
20 **NUMBER OF THE APPLICANT; AND**

21 **(II) RECORD THE APPLICANT'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR**
22 **INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER ON THE APPLICATION.**

23 (c) (1) To carry out its responsibility under State and federal law, the
24 Administration may request from a licensing authority information concerning any obligor
25 in arrears in paying child support through a support enforcement agency.

26 (2) A request for information by the Administration under paragraph (1) of
27 this subsection:

28 (i) shall contain:

29 1. the full name of the obligor; and

1 2. the Social Security number or, as appropriate, the partial
2 Social Security number **OR INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER** of the
3 obligor; and

4 (ii) may be transmitted to a licensing authority using an electronic
5 format.

6 (d) (1) Upon receipt of a request for information under subsection (c) of this
7 section, a licensing authority shall submit the following information to the Administration
8 with respect to each obligor who is licensed by, or has applied for a license from, the
9 licensing authority:

10 (i) the full name of the obligor;

11 (ii) the address of the obligor, if known;

12 (iii) the Social Security number or, as appropriate, the partial Social
13 Security number **OR INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER** of the obligor,
14 if known; and

15 (iv) a description of the license held by the obligor.

17 **1–227.**

18 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “IMMIGRANT” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL:**

19 **(1) WHOSE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN IS A COUNTRY OTHER THAN THE**
20 **UNITED STATES;**

21 **(2) WHO IS NOT A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES; AND**

22 **(3) WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.**

23 **(B) A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD MAY NOT DENY A LICENSE,**
24 **CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION TO AN IMMIGRANT IF THE INDIVIDUAL**
25 **OTHERWISE MEETS ALL EDUCATIONAL, TRAINING, OR PROFESSIONAL**
26 **REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION.**

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 October 1, 2023.
