CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations - State Board of Chiropractic Examiners - Disciplinary Actions and Procedures

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners to deny a license 4 5 to an applicant or take certain action against a licensee for failure to follow an order 6 of the Board; authorizing the Board to grant a stay of enforcement of a Board order 7 in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act; prohibiting a Board order from being stayed pending judicial review; authorizing the Board to appeal a decision that 8 9 reverses or modifies its order; authorizing the Board to reinstate a suspended or 10 revoked license only under certain circumstances; and generally relating to 11 chiropractors.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Subject to the hearing provisions of § 3–315 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, with or without conditions, or suspend or revoke a license, or any combination thereof, if the applicant or licensee:
- 9 (28) Violates any provision of this title; [or]
- 10 (29) Fails to submit to a criminal history records check in accordance with § 11 3–302.1 of this subtitle; **OR**
- 12 (30) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY BOARD ORDER.

- 14 (a) Except as provided in this section for an action under § 3–313 of this subtitle,
- any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board in a contested case, as defined in the
- 16 Administrative Procedure Act, may petition for judicial review as allowed by the
- 17 Administrative Procedure Act.
- 18 (b) Any person aggrieved by a final decision of the Board under § 3–313 of this subtitle may not appeal to the Secretary but may take a direct judicial appeal as provided in the Administrative Procedure Act.
- 21 (C) (1) THE BOARD MAY GRANT A STAY OF ENFORCEMENT OF A BOARD ORDER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
