A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Health Occupations – Clinical Nurse Specialists – Prescribing

3 FOR the purpose of defining "clinical nurse specialist" and "practice as a clinical nurse 4 specialist" for the purpose of authorizing clinical nurse specialists to prescribe drugs $\mathbf{5}$ and durable medical equipment under regulations adopted by the State Board of 6 Nursing; altering the definition of "authorized prescriber" for purposes of the 7 Maryland Pharmacy Act to include clinical nurse specialists; authorizing a licensed 8 physician to personally prepare and dispense a prescription written by a clinical 9 nurse specialist; and generally relating to the prescription authority of clinical nurse specialists. 10
