1 AN ACT concerning

2 Criminal Law - Child Pornography - Accessing With Intent to View and 3 Intentionally Viewing

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from knowingly or intentionally accessing <u>and</u> <u>intentionally viewing</u> a certain visual representation of a child under the age of 16 years with intent to view the visual representation; and generally relating to accessing <u>and intentionally viewing</u> child pornography with an intent to view.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Criminal Law

16 11-208.

(a) (1) In this section, "indistinguishable from an actual and identifiable child"
means an ordinary person would conclude that the image is of an actual and identifiable
minor.

1 "Indistinguishable from an actual and identifiable child" includes a (2) $\mathbf{2}$ computer-generated image that has been created, adapted, or modified to appear as an 3 actual and identifiable child.

4 (3)"Indistinguishable from an actual and identifiable child" does not $\mathbf{5}$ include images or items depicting minors that are:

- 6 (i) drawings;
- 7 (ii) cartoons;
- 8 (iii) sculptures; or
- 9 paintings. (iv)

10 (1) A person may not knowingly possess and intentionally retain, OR (b) **KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY ACCESS WITH INTENT TO VIEW**, a film, videotape, 11 12or other visual representation showing an actual child or photograph, а computer-generated image that is indistinguishable from an actual and identifiable child 13under the age of 16 years: 14

- **(I)** engaged as a subject of sadomasochistic abuse; 15(1)
- 16 (2)**(II)** engaged in sexual conduct; or
- 17(III) in a state of sexual excitement. (3)

(2) 18A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY ACCESS AND 19INTENTIONALLY VIEW A FILM, VIDEOTAPE, PHOTOGRAPH, OR OTHER VISUAL 20REPRESENTATION SHOWING AN ACTUAL CHILD OR A COMPUTER-GENERATED 21IMAGE THAT IS INDISTINGUISHABLE FROM AN ACTUAL AND IDENTIFIABLE CHILD 22UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS:

(I) ENGAGED AS A SUBJECT OF SADOMASOCHISTIC ABUSE;

- **(II)** ENGAGED IN SEXUAL CONDUCT; OR

- (III) IN A STATE OF SEXUAL EXCITEMENT.

26Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a person who (c) (1)27violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment 28not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding \$2,500 or both.

29A person who violates this section, having previously been convicted (2)30 under this section, is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not 31 exceeding 10 years or a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or both.

1 (d) Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a parent from possessing 2 visual representations of the parent's own child in the nude unless the visual 3 representations show the child engaged:

- 4 (1) as a subject of sadomasochistic abuse; or
- 5 (2) in sexual conduct and in a state of sexual excitement.
- 6 (e) It is an affirmative defense to a charge of violating this section that the person 7 promptly and in good faith:
- 8 (1) took reasonable steps to destroy each visual representation; or
- 9 (2) reported the matter to a law enforcement agency.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2023.
