- 1 (b) "Area agency" means the local agency that the Department designates in accordance with the Older Americans Act of 1965 to administer the delivery of a comprehensive and coordinated plan of social and other services and activities for seniors in a planning and service area.

- 15 (5) CONSULTING WITH AND PROVIDING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO AREA AGENCY STAFF WHO INTERACT WITH INDIVIDUALS WITH:

- 28 (A) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE

- 1 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF
- 2 \$2,400,000 TO MANAGE THE DEMENTIA CARE NAVIGATION PROGRAMS STATEWIDE
- 3 AND TO FUND THE PROGRAMS LOCALLY.
- 4 (B) THE FUNDS APPROPRIATED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE 5 DISTRIBUTED PROPORTIONALLY TO EACH AREA AGENCY BASED ON A FORMULA
- 6 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT CONSIDERS THE NEEDS AND SIZE OF
- 7 EACH JURISDICTION.
