- 4 (b) The Governor's Office of Community Initiatives shall include the following 5 units:
- 6 (1) the Governor's Office on Service and Volunteerism, under Subtitle 2 of 7 this title;
- 8 (2) the Commission on Indian Affairs, under Subtitle 3 of this title;
- 9 (3) the Commission on [LGBTQ] **LGBTQIA+** Affairs, under Subtitle 5 of 10 this title; and

13 14	[(2)] (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
15 16	[(3)] (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
17 18	(d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a member may be reappointed.
19 20	(2) A member who has served two consecutive 4-year terms may not be reappointed until at least 1 year has elapsed after the end of the previous term.
21	(e) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.
22 23	(f) A member who fails to attend at least 50% of the regularly scheduled meetings during a 12–month period shall be considered to have resigned from the Commission.
