2 Education – Maryland Civic Engagement <u>Excellence</u> Program – Established

FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Civic Engagement Excellence Program as a
 voluntary program in which local school systems may participate to recognize
 students and public schools that promote the civic readiness and civic engagement
 of students in public schools in the State; and generally relating to the establishment
 of the Maryland Civic Engagement Excellence Program.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17(A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND CIVIC18ENGAGEMENT EXCELLENCE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.

1 (B) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND CIVIC ENGAGEMENT EXCELLENCE 2 PROGRAM.

3 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO RECOGNIZE STUDENTS 4 AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS THAT PROMOTE THE CIVIC READINESS AND CIVIC 5 ENGAGEMENT OF STUDENTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE STATE.

6 (C) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY ONLY TO A LOCAL SCHOOL 7 SYSTEM THAT CHOOSES TO PARTICIPATE IN AND ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

8 (D) EACH BEGINNING WITH THE 2024–2025 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH 9 PARTICIPATING LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL:

10(1) AWARD A STUDENT A SEAL OF CIVIC ENGAGEMENT EXCELLENCE11IF THE STUDENT APPLIES AND MEETS THE CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE LOCAL12SCHOOL SYSTEM UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION; AND

13 (2) DESIGNATE A PUBLIC SCHOOL AS A CENTER OF CIVIC 14 ENGAGEMENT EXCELLENCE IF THE SCHOOL APPLIES AND MEETS THE CRITERIA 15 ADOPTED BY THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM UNDER SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION.

16 (E) (1) AT MINIMUM, A PARTICIPATING LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM'S 17 CRITERIA FOR A SEAL OF CIVIC ENGAGEMENT <u>EXCELLENCE</u> SHALL REQUIRE A 18 STUDENT TO OBTAIN FOUR TOTAL POINTS UNDER THE PROGRAM BY EARNING AT 19 LEAST ONE POINT FROM AT LEAST FOUR OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

1 (H) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2024, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER, EACH 2 PARTICIPATING LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT A 3 REPORT ON THE PROGRAM BASED ON THE MOST RECENTLY COMPLETED SCHOOL 4 YEAR.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2023.
