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- 1 AN ACT concerning
- 2 Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System Frostburg City Police Department
- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension 4 System for certain local law enforcement officers of the Frostburg City Police 5 Department under certain circumstances; providing that a certain individual is 6 entitled to eligibility service and creditable service that was earned before the 7 effective date of the Frostburg City Police Department's participation in the Law 8 Enforcement Officers' Pension System; providing that an individual who receives 9 certain service credit is not a member of and has no rights to a benefit in the 10 Employees' Pension System; providing for the transfer of creditable service for a 11 certain individual; providing for the transfer and crediting of certain assets on the 12 effective date of participation; and generally relating to the Frostburg City Police 13 Department's participation in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 3 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 4 31–2A–05.
- 5 (c) (1) On the effective date:
- 6 (i) the assets to the credit of the local plan or State system that 7 relate to the law enforcement officers, firefighters, or paramedics who elect to become 8 members shall be transferred to the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System; and
- 9 (ii) the trustee or other administrative head of the local plan or State 10 system shall certify the proportion of the funds of the local plan or State system that 11 represents the accumulated contributions of the members as of that date.
- 12 (2) The accumulated contributions shall be credited to the respective 13 annuity savings accounts of the members in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension 14 System.
- 15 (3) The balance of the funds transferred to the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System shall be offset against the special accrued liability to be funded by the participating governmental unit as provided by § 21–306.1(d) of this article.

- 19 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A LOCAL LAW 20 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE FROSTBURG CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT:
- 21 (1) IN A PERMANENT FULL—TIME POSITION BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE 22 DATE AND WHO REMAINS A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE 23 FROSTBURG CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT IN A PERMANENT FULL—TIME POSITION 24 THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE; OR
- 25 (2) IN A PERMANENT FULL-TIME POSITION AFTER THE EFFECTIVE 26 DATE.
- 27 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER **PROVISION**  $\mathbf{OF}$ LAW, IF 28 **FROSTBURG** CITY POLICE **DEPARTMENT BECOMES** A **PARTICIPATING** 29 GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM. 30 MEMBERSHIP IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IS
- 31 MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
- 32 SECTION.

- (C) IF THE FROSTBURG CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMENCES
  PARTICIPATION IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IN
  ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED
  UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE
  AND CREDITABLE SERVICE IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION
  SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE FROSTBURG CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT
  BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 8 (D) ON JOINING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM
  9 AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
  10 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION
  11 SHALL:
- 12 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION 13 SYSTEM; AND
- 14 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES' 15 PENSION SYSTEM.
- 16 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL
  17 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE
  18 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO
  19 TRANSFERS TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM UNDER THIS
  20 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE 37 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 21 (F) IF THE FROSTBURG CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT BECOMES A
  22 PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS'
  23 PENSION SYSTEM, § 31–2A–05(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER
  24 AND CREDITING OF ASSETS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 26 1, 2023.
