A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **County Police Accountability Boards – Investigation of Complaints of Police**
3 **Misconduct**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the local governing body of a county to authorize, by local
5 law, the county's police accountability board to exercise investigatory and subpoena
6 powers; authorizing a police accountability board to conduct an investigation of
7 police misconduct concurrently with a law enforcement agency investigating the
8 complaint; and generally relating to county police accountability boards.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Public Safety**

17 3–102.

18 **(E) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A LOCAL**
19 **GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY, INCLUDING BALTIMORE CITY, MAY BY LOCAL LAW**
20 **AUTHORIZE ITS POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY BOARD TO EXERCISE INVESTIGATORY**
21 **AND SUBPOENA POWERS.**

22 **(2) A POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY BOARD MAY CONDUCT AN**
23 **INVESTIGATION OF A COMPLAINT OF POLICE MISCONDUCT UNDER THIS**
