### 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13(1) VOTE TOTALS FOR EACH OFFICE OR QUESTION REPORTED14SEPARATELY BY EACH OF THE FOLLOWING VOTING METHODS, IF APPLICABLE:

- 15 (I) IN–PERSON EARLY VOTING;
- 16 (II) MAIL-IN VOTING OR VOTE-BY-MAIL;
- 17 (III) PROVISIONAL VOTING; AND
- 18 (IV) IN-PERSON ELECTION DAY VOTING; AND

19 (2) IF THE MUNICIPALITY CONDUCTS PARTISAN ELECTIONS, THE 20 PARTY AFFILIATION OF EACH CANDIDATE.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2023.
