- 2 (b) There is a **DOUGLAS J. J. PETERS** Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq 3 Conflicts Scholarship.
- 4 (k) (1) Funds for the **DOUGLAS J. J. PETERS** Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq Conflicts Scholarship shall be as provided in the annual budget of the Commission by the Governor.
- 7 (2) (i) In this subsection, "Fund" means the **DOUGLAS J. J. PETERS** 8 Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq Conflicts Scholarship Fund.
- 9 (ii) There is a **DOUGLAS J. J. PETERS** Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq Conflicts Scholarship Fund in the Commission.
- 11 (iii) The Commission shall administer the Fund.
- 12 (iv) The Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 14 (v) The State Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately and the 15 Comptroller shall account for the Fund.

- 17 1. May accept any gift or grant from any person or 18 corporation for the Fund;

- 23 (3) (i) At the end of the fiscal year, the Commission shall prepare an annual report on the Fund that includes an accounting of all financial receipts and expenditures to and from the Fund.
