1 (b) On or before the December 1 following appointment, the Commission shall 2 issue a report that contains recommendations to the County Commissioners of Washington 3 County for review and consideration.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 5 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary 6 or compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County while serving in a term of office 7 beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the 8 salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County shall take effect at the 9 beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual 10 appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2023.
