AN ACT concerning
Board of Public Works Public Comment Act
FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works, for meetings held on or after a certain date, to allow members of the public to submit certain public comments electronically except under certain circumstances; requiring public comments to be included in certain meeting materials and posted and retained online; requiring an additional staff position at the Board to carry out certain requirements; and generally relating to public comments and the Board of Public Works.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 12 REGULAR MAIL AND RELATE TO A BOARD AGENDA ITEM SHALL:
- 13 (1) BE INCLUDED IN EACH MEETING PACKET PREPARED FOR

- 15 (2) BE POSTED ONLINE AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF THE
- 16 MEETING, OR AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER THE PUBLIC COMMENT IS RECEIVED;

- 18 (3) BE RETAINED ONLINE THROUGH THE BOARD'S PUBLIC WEBSITE.
- 19 (C) ANY BOARD DISCUSSION ITEMS THAT ARE NOT SUBJECT TO INCLUSION
- 20 IN A PUBLIC AGENDA UNDER § 3–302.1 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE ARE
- 21 NOT SUBJECT TO PUBLIC COMMENT UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 22 (D) TO CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD
- 23 SHALL EMPLOY AT LEAST ONE MORE STAFF POSITION THAN THE NUMBER OF
- 24 POSITIONS AUTHORIZED IN FISCAL YEAR 2023.
