Public Senior Higher Education Institutions – Reproductive Health Services Plans – Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring, on or before a certain date, each certain public senior higher 4 education institution institutions, in consultation with students, to develop and $\mathbf{5}$ 6 implement a reproductive health services plan; requiring a certain public senior 7 higher education institution, in lieu of developing and implementing a reproductive 8 health services plan, to provide students with access to certain contraception through 9 certain means; requiring the Maryland Department of Health, on request, to provide 10 assistance to a public senior higher education institution in developing the plan; and 11 generally relating to reproductive health services and public senior higher education 12institutions.
