BY adding to Article - Education Section 16-322 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 16-322.IN THIS SECTION, "QUALIFYING STUDENT" MEANS A COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENT WHO RECEIVES A TUITION OR RESIDENCY WAIVER AS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 24 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE APPROPRIATION REQUIRED
- 25 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO EACH BOARD OF TRUSTEES BASED ON
- 26 THE NUMBER OF ENROLLED QUALIFYING STUDENTS AT EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
- 27 IN PROPORTION TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ENROLLED QUALIFYING STUDENTS, AS
- 28 DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION.
- 29 (D) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT ANY REGULATIONS OR GUIDELINES
- 30 NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 31 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2024, AND EACH DECEMBER 1 THROUGH
- 32 December 1, 2027 Thereafter, the Commission shall report to the

- 1 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
- 2 ARTICLE, ON THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS RECEIVING A TUITION OR RESIDENCY
- 3 WAIVER FOR EACH CATEGORY LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION FOR
- 4 EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS PROVIDED TO EACH
- 5 COMMUNITY COLLEGE UNDER THIS SECTION.

6	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7	1, 2023.
