- 3 (B) IF AN EMPLOYER USES A DELIVERY EMPLOYEE TO DELIVER A PRODUCT, 4 THE EMPLOYER SHALL:
- 5 (1) REIMBURSE THE DELIVERY EMPLOYEE FOR MILEAGE IN AN
- 6 AMOUNT THAT IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE MOST RECENT INTERNAL REVENUE
- 7 SERVICE STANDARD MILEAGE RATE; AND
- 8 (2) POST CONSPICUOUSLY IN A PLACE WHERE THE DELIVERY
- 9 EMPLOYEE IS EMPLOYED A PRINTED NOTICE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION
- 10 IN A FORM THAT THE COMMISSIONER REQUIRES.
- 11 (C) FOR CALCULATING REIMBURSEMENT FOR MILEAGE UNDER THIS
- 12 SECTION, A DELIVERY EMPLOYEE SHALL CALCULATE THE DISTANCE IN MILES
- 13 DRIVEN USING A RECOGNIZED, REPUTABLE, INTERNET MAPPING PROGRAM OR
- 14 APPLICATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2023.
