1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Garrett County – Tax Sales – Auctioneer Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the auctioneer’s fee for the tax sale of property in Garrett
4 County; and generally relating to tax sales of property in Garrett County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Tax – Property**

18 14–813.

1 (e) (1) The following expenses relating to the sale shall be allowed, all of which
2 are liens on the property to be sold:

3 (iv) the auctioneer's fee, as provided in paragraph (2) of this
4 subsection;

5 (2) The auctioneer's fee allowed in paragraph (1) of this subsection shall
6 be:

7 (i) except in Baltimore City, Caroline County, Carroll County, Cecil
8 County, Dorchester County, Frederick County, Garrett County, Harford County, Howard
9 County, Kent County, Prince George's County, Queen Anne's County, Somerset County, St.
10 Mary's County, Talbot County, Wicomico County, or Worcester County:

11 1. for any date when 1, 2, or 3 properties are sold, an amount
12 not to exceed \$10; and

13 2. for any date when 4 or more properties are sold, \$3 for each
14 property sold;

15 (ii) in Dorchester County, \$7.50 for each property sold;

16 (iii) in Kent County, an amount not exceeding \$7.50 for each property
17 sold;

18 (iv) in Cecil County and Queen Anne's County, \$7.50 for each
19 property sold;

20 (v) in [Garrett County,] Somerset County[,] and Wicomico County,
21 \$8 for each property sold;

22 (vi) in Worcester County, the greater of \$8 for each property sold or
23 \$300, to be allocated pro rata among each property sold;

24 (vii) in Baltimore City:

25 1. for any date when 1, 2, or 3 properties are sold, an amount
26 not to exceed \$10;

27 2. for any date when 4 or more properties are sold, \$3 for each
28 property sold; and

29 3. in an electronic sale, an amount not to exceed \$10 for each
30 property sold;

31 (viii) in Carroll County, the amount set by the Carroll County
32 Commissioners;

1 (ix) in Caroline County, **GARRETT COUNTY**, Harford County,
2 Howard County, Prince George's County, and Talbot County, \$10 for each property sold;

3 (x) in Frederick County, the lowest responsive bid for each property
4 sold; and

5 (xi) in St. Mary's County, the actual cost charged by the auctioneer
6 for each property sold.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2023.
