



- 16 appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. 17
- 18 (b) In making appointments to the State Board, the Governor shall 19 consider representation from:
- 20 (i) All parts of this State; and
- 21 (ii) Areas of this State with concentrations of population or unique 22needs.

SENATE BILL 394

- 1 The dismissal of or other disciplinary action involving personnel; (i) 2 or 3 (ii) Appeals to the State Board under § 2–205 of this subtitle or § 4-205 or § 6-202 of this article. 4 5 Each regular member serves for a term of 4 years and until a successor 6 is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the 7 members serving on the State Board as of July 1, 1989.
- 8 (2) The Governor shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on the 9 Board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 10 (3) A member is eligible for reappointment but may not serve for more than 11 two full 4—year terms.
- 12 (4) The student member shall serve for a term of 1 year. A student member 13 is eligible for reappointment but may not serve more than two full 1–year terms.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor shall appoint, in accordance with § 2–202(b)(5) of the Education Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, the initial principal member of the State Board of Education, who shall serve for a term of 2 years and 6 months beginning January 1, 2024, and terminating at the end of June 30, 2026, or until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
