BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 14 15 3-801.16 (a) The Kent County Board consists of [five]: **(1)** 17 FIVE VOTING members; AND 18 **(2)** ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER. 19 A candidate elected to the county board shall be a resident and (b) **(1)** registered voter of Kent County. 20

- 1 Any member who no longer resides in Kent County may not continue **(2)** 2 as a member of the board. 3 The incumbent VOTING members of the Kent County Board who hold 4 office on July 1, 2010, shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualify.
