- 28 (2) the accessibility of the place of business or activity to the public;

- 30 (4) the volume of expected sales.

- 1 is consistent with the holding in the case of Chesapeake Amusements Inc. v. Riddle, 363
- 2 Md. 16 (2001), in that the element of chance must be wholly within the pre-printed instant
- 3 lottery ticket, and that player enhancements in an instant ticket lottery machine may not
- 4 affect the element of chance being wholly within the pre-printed instant lottery ticket.
- 5 (e) The Director may not issue a license to:
- 6 (1) a person or governmental unit to engage in business primarily as a 7 licensed agent; or
- 8 (2) an individual who is under the age of 21 years.
- 9 (f) The Commission may hear and decide an appeal of a denial of a license.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
