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1 (g) On or before December 30, 2023, the Workgroup shall report its findings and 2 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State 3 Government Article, the General Assembly.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 5 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 6 30, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be 7 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
