1 AN ACT concerning

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## Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror 2 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror to study establishing a memorial dedicated to Marylanders who have 4 5 fought in the Global War on Terror and their families; and generally relating to the Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror. 6 7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 8 That: 9 There is a Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror. (a) 10 (b) The Commission consists of the following members: 11 (1) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, or the Secretary's designee; 12 (2)the Secretary of General Services, or the Secretary's designee; 13 (3)two representatives of the Maryland Veterans Commission, designated by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs; 14 15 **(4)** four representatives of veteran services organizations, designated by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs; and 16 one representative of the Maryland National Guard, designated by the 17 Adjutant General of Maryland. 18 19 The members of the Commission shall elect a chair from among the 20 Commission's members.

The Department of Veterans Affairs shall provide staff for the Commission.



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- 2 (1) may not receive compensation; but
- 3 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 4 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
  - (f) The Commission shall provide recommendations for the funding, design, construction, and placement of an appropriate memorial dedicated to Marylanders who fought in the Global War on Terror and their families.
- 8 (g) On or before 7 months after the effective date of this Act, the Commission shall 9 submit a preliminary report on its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in 10 accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- 11 (h) On or before 1 year and 3 months after the effective date of this Act, the Commission shall submit a final report on its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of Chapter 423 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2022. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
