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- 18 The Board of County Commissioners will meet in public session [weekly] AT LEAST TWICE A MONTH. THE BOARD MAY HOLD PUBLIC MEETINGS IN PERSON OR OVER 19 VIDEO BROADCAST THROUGH LIVE VIDEO STREAMING. THE BOARD MAY NOT MEET 20

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SOLELY THROUGH LIVE VIDEO STREAMING FOR MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE MEETINGS WITHOUT A FORMAL DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY. The Board will provide notice of all public meeting dates and times to include notification of any change in schedule or cancellation. The Board will schedule/announce administrative sessions to review matters that may require executive action during forthcoming public sessions or to address personnel, administrative, or other subjects. Each Commissioner will attend appointed commission, board or committee meetings as scheduled or planned.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2023.
