Gaming - Video Lottery Operation License - Renewal

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a certain number of years before the expiration of a certain term of a video lottery operation license the licensee file a certain notice with 4 5 the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission; requiring a video lottery 6 operation licensee, within a certain number of years after filing a certain notice, to 7 file an application to renew a certain license that includes a certain payment; 8 requiring the Commission to renew a certain license unless the Commission makes 9 a certain finding; and generally relating to the renewal of video lottery operation licenses. 10

- 20 (a) The initial term of a video lottery operation license is 15 years from the date 21 on which the video lottery facility is issued the license by the Commission.
 - (b) During the initial term of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall provide the Commission with an annual update of the information required under this subtitle for the issuance of a license by the date set by the Commission in regulations and on the form required by the Commission.



- 1 (c) Two years before the expiration of the INITIAL 15-YEAR LICENSE term OR
 2 A RENEWAL TERM of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall file with the
 3 Commission a notice of intent to [reapply for] APPLY FOR RENEWAL OF the license under
 4 this subtitle.
- 5 (d) (1) This subsection applies to the first renewal of a video 6 Lottery operation license following the initial 15-year term and each 7 Subsequent renewal of the license.
- 8 (2) A RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE IS FOR A 9 TERM OF 10 YEARS.
- 10 (3) Within 1 year [of the end of the initial 15-year license term] AFTER
 11 FILING A NOTICE OF INTENT UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, a video lottery
 12 operation licensee [may reapply for a] SHALL FILE AN APPLICATION TO RENEW A VIDEO
 13 LOTTERY OPERATION license [that has a license term of 10 years and a] THAT INCLUDES
 14 THE PAYMENT OF THE license RENEWAL fee to be established by [statute] THE
- 15 COMMISSION BY REGULATION.
- 16 (4) ON PROPER APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY
 17 OPERATION LICENSE, THE COMMISSION SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE UNLESS THE
 18 COMMISSION FINDS THAT THE LICENSEE IS NO LONGER QUALIFIED UNDER THIS
 19 SUBTITLE TO HOLD A LICENSE.
- 20 (5) BEFORE DENYING AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, 21 THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE THE VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE AN 22 OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING.
- 23 (6) THE COMMISSION, BY REGULATION, SHALL:
- 24 (I) ESTABLISH AN APPLICATION PROCESS TO RENEW A VIDEO 25 LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE; AND
- 26 (II) SET THE LICENSE FEE FOR RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE, AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 28 (e) If a licensee has its license revoked or otherwise surrenders the license, the 29 video lottery operation license reverts to the State.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
