1 AN ACT concerning

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Gaming – Video Lottery Operation License – Renewal

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a certain number of years before the expiration of a certain term of a video lottery operation license the licensee file a certain notice with 4 $\mathbf{5}$ the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission; requiring a video lottery 6 operation licensee, within a certain number of years after filing a certain notice, to 7 file an application to renew a certain license that includes a certain payment; 8 requiring the Commission to renew a certain license unless the Commission makes 9 a certain finding; and generally relating to the renewal of video lottery operation 10 licenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – State Government

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1 (a) The initial term of a video lottery operation license is 15 years from the date 2 on which the video lottery facility is issued the license by the Commission.

3 (b) During the initial term of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall 4 provide the Commission with an annual update of the information required under this 5 subtitle for the issuance of a license by the date set by the Commission in regulations and 6 on the form required by the Commission.

7 (c) Two years before the expiration of the INITIAL 15-YEAR LICENSE term OR 8 A RENEWAL TERM of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall file with the 9 Commission a notice of intent to [reapply for] APPLY FOR RENEWAL OF the license under 10 this subtitle.

11 (d) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO THE FIRST RENEWAL OF A VIDEO
 12 LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE FOLLOWING THE INITIAL 15-YEAR TERM AND EACH
 13 SUBSEQUENT RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE.

14(2)A RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE IS FOR A15TERM OF 10 YEARS.

(3) Within 1 year [of the end of the initial 15-year license term] AFTER
FILING A NOTICE OF INTENT UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, a video lottery
operation licensee [may reapply for a] SHALL FILE AN APPLICATION TO RENEW A VIDEO
LOTTERY OPERATION license [that has a license term of 10 years and a] THAT INCLUDES
THE PAYMENT OF THE license RENEWAL fee to be established by [statute] THE
COMMISSION BY REGULATION.

(4) ON PROPER APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY
OPERATION LICENSE, THE COMMISSION SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE UNLESS THE
COMMISSION FINDS THAT THE LICENSEE IS NO LONGER QUALIFIED UNDER THIS
SUBTITLE TO HOLD A LICENSE.

26 (5) BEFORE DENYING AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION,
 27 THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE THE VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE AN
 28 OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING.

29(6)THE COMMISSION SHALL PAY THE RENEWAL LICENSE FEES30SUBMITTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO THE EDUCATION31TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 9–1A–30 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- 32 (6) (7) THE COMMISSION, BY REGULATION, SHALL:
- 33(I)ESTABLISH AN APPLICATION PROCESS TO RENEW A VIDEO34LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE; AND

$\frac{3}{4}$	(e) If a licensee has its license revoked or otherwise surrenders the license, the video lottery operation license reverts to the State.

6	(c) (1) There shall be credited to the Education Trust Fund:
7 8	(I) <u>all proceeds allocated to the Fund under § 9–1A–27 of this</u> <u>subtitle [and]</u> ;

$\begin{array}{c} 13\\14 \end{array}$	(2) <u>Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be invested and reinvested</u> by the Treasurer, and interest and earnings shall accrue to the Fund.
