SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO SMALL FOOD BANKS IN THE STATE.
6-904.
IN DETERMINING WHICH ENTITIES TO SUPPORT UNDER THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRIORITIZE ENTITIES THAT:
(1) ARE NONPROFIT ENTITIES REGISTERED IN THE STATE;
(2) CONDUCT ASSESSMENTS, WITH ONGOING DATA COLLECTION TO TRACK SUCCESS; AND
(3) CAN DEMONSTRATE:
(I) STRONG COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AND PARTNERSHIPS, BOTH PRESENTLY AND HISTORICALLY;
(II) CONSISTENT STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT, INCLUDING ENGAGEMENT WITH LOCAL GOVERNMENT, BUSINESSES, SOCIAL SERVICES, AGENCIES, AND COMMUNITY LEADERS;
(III) SUSTAINABILITY, WITH DIVERSE FUNDING STREAMS SO AS NOT TO BE RELIANT ON ONE SOURCE;
(IV) INNOVATION THROUGH ENGAGEMENT WITH NONTRADITIONAL PARTNERS; AND
(V) A FOCUS ON UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES WITH A COMMITMENT TO EQUITY.
6-905.
FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION NOT EXCEEDING \$3,000,000 TO THE PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.

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
