A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

State Procurement – Minority Business Enterprises and Small Business Enterprises – Procurement Forecast, Employee Performance, and Outreach (Small Business Protection Act of Maryland)

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of requiring each unit to publish on the unit's website annually a certain 6 procurement forecast; requiring a unit determining eligibility for a merit increase or 7 performance-based promotion for a certain procurement officer or certain other 8 employee to consider certain efforts by the officer or employee in meeting certain 9 minority enterprise participation goals; prohibiting a certain procurement officer or certain other employee from receiving a certain promotion or merit increase under 10 11 certain circumstances; requiring a certain procurement officer or certain other 12employee to have their employment with the unit terminated or be reassigned to a 13 certain other position under certain circumstances; requiring the Office of Small, 14 Minority, and Women Business Affairs to consult with each primary procurement 15unit to identify potential contracting opportunities for and increase outreach efforts 16 to small businesses; requiring the Office to develop a certain program; and generally 17relating to minority business enterprise and small business enterprise participation 18 in State procurement.

16 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, WHEN A UNIT IS DETERMINING 17 ELIGIBILITY FOR A MERIT INCREASE OR PERFORMANCE–BASED PROMOTION FOR A 18 PROCUREMENT OFFICER OR OTHER EMPLOYEE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROCURING 19 GOODS AND SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE UNIT, THE UNIT SHALL CONSIDER THE 20EFFORTS OF THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE TO ASSIST THE UNIT IN MEETING A MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE GOAL SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS 2122SUBTITLE.

23**(B)** NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, IF A UNIT DOES NOT MEET A 24MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE GOAL SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE. 25THE UNIT'S PROCUREMENT OFFICER AND ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE RESPONSIBLE FOR 26PROCURING GOODS AND SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THAT UNIT:

27(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE ANY MERIT INCREASE OR PROMOTION BASED 28ON THEIR PERFORMANCE DURING ANY FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THE GOAL IS NOT MET 29AND THERE IS NO IMPROVEMENT OVER THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR TOWARD 30 **MEETING THAT GOAL; AND**

IF THERE IS NO IMPROVEMENT TOWARD MEETING THE GOAL 31(2) 32OVER 3 CONSECUTIVE FISCAL YEARS, SHALL HAVE THEIR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE 33 UNIT TERMINATED OR BE REASSIGNED TO A POSITION THAT DOES NOT INCLUDE 34 INVOLVEMENT WITH THE UNIT'S PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES.

5 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 6 INDICATED.

7 (2) "PRIMARY PROCUREMENT UNIT" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 8 11–101 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

9 (3) "SMALL BUSINESS" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 14–501 OF 10 THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

11 (B) THE OFFICE SHALL CONSULT WITH EACH PRIMARY PROCUREMENT 12 UNIT TO IDENTIFY POTENTIAL CONTRACTING OPPORTUNITIES FOR AND INCREASE 13 OUTREACH EFFORTS TO SMALL BUSINESSES.

14 (C) THE OFFICE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE PRIMARY PROCUREMENT 15 UNITS, SHALL DEVELOP A PROGRAM TO:

16 (1) IDENTIFY AND INCREASE AWARENESS OF PROCUREMENT 17 OPPORTUNITIES FOR SMALL BUSINESSES CONTRACTS FOR SERVICES AND 18 SUPPLIES;

19(2) ASSIST SMALL BUSINESSES IN COMPLYING WITH PROCEDURES20WITH BIDDING ON A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT OR RESPONDING TO A REQUEST FOR21PROPOSALS.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2023.
