22	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
23	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance 2 Program.
- 3 (5) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE STATE BUDGET, AND AS 4 PERMITTED BY FEDERAL LAW, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 5 (I) SUBJECT TO ITEM (II)2 OF THIS PARAGRAPH, ADOPT 6 12-MONTH CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE PROGRAM AND 7 THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM; AND
- 8 (II) 1. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2024, APPLY TO THE 9 CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES FOR A STATE PLAN 10 AMENDMENT OR WAIVER UNDER § 1115 OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, IF 11 NECESSARY, TO ADOPT 24-MONTH CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULTS AND 12 CHILDREN UNDER THE PROGRAM AND THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH 13 PROGRAM; AND
- 2. If APPROVED BY THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICE, ADOPT 24-MONTH CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN UNDER THE PROGRAM AND THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
