1 AN ACT concerning

Electronic Health Networks and Electronic Medical Records – Nursing Homes – Release of Records

FOR the purpose of authorizing a nursing home that contracts with or uses an electronic
health network or electronic medical record vendor, with the consent of the patient
or patient's personal representative, to direct the network or vendor to release
electronic medical records and electronic health care transactions to a business
associate of the nursing home; and generally relating to electronic health networks
and electronic medical records.

(II) SHALL MAKE THE PATIENT MEDICAL RECORDS OR
 ELECTRONIC HEALTH CARE TRANSACTIONS AVAILABLE ON A REGULAR BASIS AND
 RELEASE THE INFORMATION IN A TIMELY MANNER TO SUPPORT PATIENT CARE AND
 MONITORING; AND

30 (III) MAY NOT RESTRICT, LIMIT, OR CHARGE A FEE FOR OR LIMIT
 31 THE RELEASE OF THE PATIENT MEDICAL RECORDS OR ELECTRONIC HEALTH CARE

 CONTRACTED WITH THE STATE-DESIGNATED HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE TO

<u>IMPROVE NURSING HOME QUALITY THROUGH DATA INTEGRATION, UNLESS THE FEE</u> <u>IS APPROVED BY THE STATE-DESIGNATED HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE.</u>

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 1, 2023.
