2 Agriculture - Confinement of Egg-Laying Hens in Commercial Egg Production -3 **Prohibitions**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a farm owner or operator from knowingly confining certain egg-laying hens in an enclosure in a certain manner, subject to certain exceptions, 6 on or after a certain date; prohibiting a business owner or operator or a farm owner or operator from selling shell eggs or egg products under certain circumstances on or after a certain date; specifying that a certain certification be obtained in a certain manner to sell shell eggs and egg products; and generally relating to confinement of egg-laying hens in commercial egg production.

- 1 (2) "EGG PRODUCTS" INCLUDES RAW AND COOKED EGGS, EGGS WITH 2 THE YOLKS AND WHITES IN THEIR NATURAL PROPORTIONS, AND EGGS WITH THE 3 YOLKS AND WHITES SEPARATED, MIXED, OR MIXED AND STRAINED.
- 4 (3) "EGG PRODUCTS" DOES NOT INCLUDE COMBINATION FOOD 5 PRODUCTS THAT ARE COMPOSED OF MORE THAN JUST EGG.
- 6 (E) "FARM" MEANS THE LAND, BUILDINGS, SUPPORT FACILITIES, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT THAT ARE WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY USED FOR THE COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION OF ANIMALS OR ANIMAL PRODUCTS USED FOR FOOD, NOT INCLUDING LIVE ANIMAL MARKETS AND OFFICIAL PLANTS AT WHICH MANDATORY INSPECTION IS MAINTAINED UNDER 21 U.S.C. § 1031 ET SEQ.
- 11 (F) "FARM OWNER OR OPERATOR" DOES NOT INCLUDE AN OWNER OR 12 OPERATOR OF A FARM THAT PRODUCES SHELL EGGS FROM FEWER THAN 3,000 EGG-LAYING HENS.
- 14 (G) "SHELL EGGS" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4–301 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 15 (H) (1) "USABLE FLOOR SPACE" MEANS THE TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE OF
 16 FLOOR SPACE PROVIDED TO EACH EGG—LAYING HEN, AS CALCULATED BY DIVIDING
 17 THE TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE OF THE FLOOR SPACE IN THE ENCLOSURE BY THE
 18 NUMBER OF EGG—LAYING HENS IN THAT ENCLOSURE.
- 19 (2) "USABLE FLOOR SPACE" INCLUDES GROUND AND ELEVATED 20 LEVEL OR NEARLY LEVEL FLAT PLATFORMS UPON WHICH HENS CAN ROOST.

- 24 FROM THE DEPARTMENT VERIFYING THAT THE SHELL EGGS OR EGG PRODUCTS ARE
- 25 PRODUCED IN COMPLIANCE WITH § 3–1102 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 26 (2) If A FARM OWNER OR OPERATOR IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A
- 27 CERTIFICATE FROM THE DEPARTMENT UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
- 28 BUSINESS OWNER OR OPERATOR SHALL OBTAIN A COPY OF THE CERTIFICATE FROM

- 2 PROCESS VERIFICATION PROVIDER THAT IS APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY TO
- 3 ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.

- 5 (A) IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT SHELL EGGS OR EGG PRODUCTS ARE
- 6 BEING SOLD IN VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY ISSUE A
- 7 WRITTEN OR PRINTED "STOP-SALE" ORDER TO THE PERSON VIOLATING THIS
